What: SCC moves into the next subgroup of Phase 1B by adding vaccinations for educators and essential workers
When: January 27, 2021
Where: Santa Cruz County

Santa Cruz County, AZ – Santa Cruz County (SCC) and Mariposa Community Health Center announce the following developments and plans for the continuation of the COVID-19 vaccination program.

SCC is currently in Phase 1B of vaccine distribution and will expand our vaccinations by adding individuals in the following subgroups;

- Educators and childcare workers
- Essential workers (defined below)
 - Food and agriculture related occupations (packaging and distribution workers, grocery and restaurant workers)
 - Power and utility workers
 - State or local government workers that provide critical services for the continuity of government
 - Transportation & material moving occupations (public transportation providers, airlines, gas stations, auto shop workers and other transport services)
 - Other essential workers (e.g., business and financial services, supply chain for critical goods, funeral services, critical trades, etc.)

All residents in Phase 1B wishing to receive the vaccine are asked to pre-register online [here](#). Residents who have already pre-registered do not need to do anything. Once residents have pre-registered, they will receive a phone call from the SCC Call Center when vaccine appointments are available for the subgroup that individual falls into. If you do not have access to internet, you can pre-register by calling 520-375-7626. **Currently, appointments cannot be made through email or by phone.**

This is not an appointment portal, but will expedite the appointment and final registration process. The pre-registration portal is available 24 hours a day.
