What: Santa Cruz County Mass Vaccination Program ends

The Santa Cruz County mass vaccination program will end vaccinations at the Nogales Recreation Center on June 17, 2021.

Vaccinations will continue over the next two weeks for individuals who live or are employed in Santa Cruz County, and are 12 years or older. The final four days to receive vaccination at the Nogales Recreation Center clinic are listed below:

Tuesday	June 8 th	8:00 am to 2:00 pm
Wednesday	June 9 th	8:00 am to 2:00 pm
Friday	June 11 th	8:00 am to 2:00 pm
Thursday	June 17 th	8:00 am to 2:00 pm

During the last four days of the clinic, the Moderna, Pfizer, and Johnson & Johnson vaccinations will be administered. Individuals may schedule an appointment, however walk-ins will be accepted on the dates and times listed above.
