The starting salary for a Tier I and Tier II credentialed staff interpreter is \$43,491 (\$20.91 an hour).

Furthermore, staff interpreters are eligible for, among other things:  
health insurance; vacation days (13); sick leave days (13) and holidays (10).

The salary jumps to \$45,692 (\$21.97 an hour) upon earning the Tier III credential.  
Additionally, there is a 3% increase in pay every three years (for service in the same classification).

If you prefer to work as a contract employee (i.e., you are not an employee of the court)  
and are contracted to work partial days or full days, the compensation is as follows:  
\$50 per hour (two hour minimum) / \$200 for half a day / \$300 for a full day  
(contract employees do not receive any fringe benefits and are needed sporadically)
